Utilize best practices in management of cardiovascular arrest emergencies requiring ACLS, such as cardiac arrest and refractory ventricular fibrillation, and assess best use of nurse-led codes, TEE and POCUS, and post-arrest care methods; Identify optimal strategies for utilizing methods such as ATLS, MTPs, TEE, FAST, and permissive hypotension to best manage trauma presentations.
2. Apply effective strategies to manage shock and sepsis in the setting of adrenal insufficiency, liver disease, and anaphylaxis; Utilize best practices in management of airway and ventilation emergencies, such as pre-oxygenation, medication administration, and proning, and utilize APRV, VExUS score, and end-tidal CO<sub>2</sub> to assess and monitor patient status and apply appropriate care; Apply techniques to improve outcomes when performing intubation, utilizing video laryngoscopy, managing difficult airways, and performing surgical airway, including cricothyrotomy and other methods.
3. Apply techniques to manage patients presenting with cardiogenic emergencies (such as unstable atrial fibrillation, valvular disorders, and chest pain in pregnant women) effectively, and improve outcomes with the use of echocardiography, mechanical circulatory support, and other methods; Assess the evidence for brain cooling after stroke and extending the treatment window for cerebrovascular accidents to develop management strategies; utilize best practices in management of neurocritical care emergencies, such as non-convulsive status epilepticus and subarachnoid hemorrhage.
